CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE SALE BY PROFIT-SHARE

We welcome all contributions of clothing for babies and children up to 12 years – size 152, toys, children's books in sufficiently good condition to appeal to our relatively affluent Luxembourg community. Proceeds from the sale help us to buy books for the library, to help with the training and continuing education of group leaders, and to aid La Leche League groups in less fortunate countries.

Clothing and small items (toys, books): 30% commission to LLL.

For the smooth running of our sale, we are obliged to impose the following conditions:

1. Items to be sold on commission **MUST** be labelled and priced by the contributor (see #5 below) and made available **THE DAY BEFORE THE SALE between 10.30 am and 2.30 pm**. You are kindly requested to **arrange your items on the sales table assigned to you**. Items received unlabelled will be considered donations.
2. We reserve the right to refuse items considered unsuitable for the sale (clothing which is soiled, stained, torn or very worn, equipment and toys not in working order or considered dangerous). **Stained and worn-out items will not be put on sale. Please close the boxes containing puzzles and games with a tape. Before control they are complete! We commit ourselves to keep a black list with sellers, which we do not accept any more, because the goods are either dirty or damaged, do not meet the conditions or the seller has not picked up his unsold items.**
3. Shoes in general are discouraged, unless in as new condition and large size shoes, over 35, will not be accepted.
4. Complicated equipment should be accompanied by the manufacturer's instructions, or at least an explanatory note written by the contributor. Faulty goods should not be offered for sale.
5. Labels should be clearly written and well attached. Please do not attach labels to clothes hangers. For clothing, labels can be made from strong paper or cloth and **sewn or stapled to a clothing tag** (no pins please and beware sticky labels are likely to fall off). **Please do not staple in the fabric of the clothes.** A label should include the following information:
 - 3-letter ID code of seller as allocated by LLL (see #7 below)
 - the price in euros - see suggestion list overleaf
 - all prices should end in zero (multiples of 10c)
 - multiple-piece items should be secured together and the number of pieces indicated on the label
 - sticky labels or cards tied on with string can be used on toys or equipment

Please make sure your ID-code is clearly readable otherwise we cannot guarantee that it will be attributed to you.

6. Contributors **MUST pick up** their unsold items at the **end of the sale, (at 3 p.m.)**.
7. Each seller has to demand a 3-letter ID code which is allocated by the organiser. Contributors will be asked to supply their name, address, telephone number, email and details of their local bank account (name of bank and account name, account number) so that profits can be transferred to the account within 28 days after the sale.
8. The organiser cannot be held responsible for the theft of or damage to items contributed by commission sellers, although they will do their utmost to prevent this from happening.
9. A guideline to help you with pricing is given overleaf.

Suggested Price Guidelines

This list is by no means exhaustive: we have tried to give examples to help you price your contributions. Of course, if in any doubt, please do not hesitate to contact the organiser.

Our prices are usually lower than you would expect to find in small ads and second-hand shops. **Price depends on the quality, the material (e.g. 100% natural fibres are priced higher than synthetics), the size, and the condition of the item.**

SHORT SLEEVE TOPS & T-SHIRTS:

T-shirt	1-€5
Blouse/shirt	€2-€6

LONG SLEEVE TOPS

Blouse/shirt	€3-€10
Long sleeve shirt	€2-5
sweatshirt	€3-€8

SKIRTS:

light summer skirt	€2-€6
woollen winter skirt	€4-€10

DRESSES:

sleeveless summer dress	€3-€8
fancy, embroidered, smocked etc	€5-€20
pure wool winter dress	> €10

TROUSERS, JEANS, DUNGAREES:

plain summer	€2.50-€8
denim dungarees	€3-€10
age 0-3, as new, denim, wool, lined	€5
age 3 and over, price range	€5-€15

SHORTS:

toddlers	50c -€3
age 3 and over, price range	€2-€5

SWEATERS, CARDIGANS:

baby jacket	€1.50-€3

(higher price for wool than synthetic)

2 pieces, age 1 up	€2.50-€8
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BABY-GROS:

plain	€2-€5
fancy day clothes	up to €8
2-3 piece sets, very elaborate	€5-€12

TRACKSUITS:

must be in excellent condition - no holes	
age 0-3	€2-€5
age 3 and over	€5-10

COATS, JACKETS, ANORAKS, SKI SUITS:

baby, nylon zip-up snowsuit	€3-€10
very fancy snowsuit, good condition	€8-€20
plain lightweight jacket, good condition	€3-€10
wool winter coat, good condition	€5-€20

GLOVES, BONNETS, SCARVES:

50c -€2

SWIMSUITS:

€2-€5

FOOTWEAR:

generally very low prices, **must be as new & clean, smaller than size 36**

leather shoes, maximum price	€10
good rubber or plastic rain boots	€2

LINENS:

fitted all cotton cot sheet	€2.50
baby nest	€2.50-€10
cot sleeping bag	€2.50-€10
baby blanket	€3-€10
cot bumpers	€2.50-€10
terry, cloth nappies/diapers, as new	6 for €8
hooded towels	€1.50-€2.50

TOYS:

small	€1
good soft toys	€2-€4
puzzles	€2-€4
books (price in pencil on 1st page please)	€1-€3
games	€1.50-€5
large games	€3-€15

Brand new (unworn) or fancy handmade items should be labelled and priced as such, at your discretion.

We cannot accept baby feeding bottles or related equipment. Neither can we accept any electrical goods, baby carriers, maternity clothes, strollers, car seats nor any furniture!
